Location:

Varies based upon monthly meeting within 46201 or 46203

Purpose:

Block Pawtrols are walking different neighborhoods in the communities of 46201 and 46203 to distribute animal welfare materials with other volunteers.

Key Responsibilities:

- Distribution of information detailing the current resources, information on upcoming events or expansion of resources, identification of neighbors in need of services

Reports To:

Block Captain and Community Outreach Coordinator

Time Commitment:

Minimum donation of 2 hours/month required.

Volunteer availability is only on one to two Saturday's a month.

Qualifications:

- Must be able to interact positively with community members and other volunteers
- Friendly, pleasant manner
- Dependability
- Can walk comfortably for up to one hour

Age Requirement:

Must be at least 21 years of age

Training:

- Information Session
- Basic Training
