- Provide the foster animals with the proper care while in your home – food, water, shelter, and the appropriate amount of socialization. _____
- Should you choose to keep the animal you will alert the Foster Care Manager and schedule a spay/neuter appointment at the Animal Welfare Center. _____
- Use supplies given by IndyHumane for foster animals only and return any unused and remaining supplies at time of intake appointment. ___
- Administer medication to the foster animals ONLY at the recommendations of the veterinary staff of IndyHumane. _____
- You will not sell or adopt foster animals from your home. Potential adopters need to be directed to IndyHumane staff. _____
- Agree to work within the parameters of the adoption policies of IndyHumane when speaking with potential adopters. _____
- Not hold IndyHumane responsible for any medical treatment or the cost of any medical treatment that your animals may need as a result of fostering. _____
- Understand and agree that IndyHumane is not responsible for any medical costs you or your family may incur as a result of fostering. _____
- Agree to direct all “media” requests to IndyHumane’s marketing manager. “Media” includes all T.V., radio, print or online requests. _____
- The Humane Society of Indianapolis reserves the right to release foster care parents immediately if the situation is unsafe or unproductive. _____
- Agree to offer your time and services to IndyHumane purely as a volunteer, without any expectation of payment compensation or benefit of any kind. _____
