



## IndyHumane Dog Park: Rules, Etiquette, and Important Points to Remember

- Dogs must be leashed upon entering and exiting the Dog Park.
- Dogs must be supervised 100% of the time and need to be maintained under voice control. If your dog acts aggressively toward another dog, please leash your dog and exit the park. Always watch your dog – you are responsible for his or her actions. Stop rough play if other dogs are not enjoying the play style. Remember, just because your dog enjoys playing rough doesn't mean other dogs are having fun!
- Please clean up after your dog and yourself before leaving the park. There are waste containers available for your disposal.
- Avoid using toys or food if there are other dogs around you or your dog. Please be cautious when giving out treats to your dog, as some dogs may become reactive or try to guard the food. Never give treats to another member's dog without asking permission.
- Please do not bring items made of glass into the park.
- Pet owners should not bring human food into the park.
- Your membership is only for you and your dog(s) listed on your application – for your safety, never allow anyone else or another dog into the park. Do not share your fob with non-members. If someone is unable to get into the park, it could be because they are not a member, their membership has expired, or they have been suspended.
- Children under the age of 12 are not permitted in the park. Do not allow your children to play with other member's dogs.
- Smoking is not allowed in the park or on the walking trails.
- If your pet becomes aggressive towards people or other dogs, your membership may be subject to termination without refund of membership fees.
- Please do not carry your key fob along with your credit or debit card, or with any barcode scanner cards. Doing this may cause your key fob to deactivate and you will be required to purchase a replacement fob.
- Report dog bites **immediately** to shelter staff or call 317-872-5650 x0. It is **your responsibility** to obtain complete information for everyone involved in a dog bite incident.
